HAVE A VOTING PL

Register. Make sure everyone you know is registered. Stay informed. Make sure everyone you know is informed. Vote. Make sure everyone you know votes.

REGISTER TO VOTE, CHECK YOUR STATUS AND ADDRESS

Go to **lwvstamford.org** Quick Links. In order to be eligible to vote, you must:

- ✓ be a United States citizen
- be at least 17 years old (must turn 18 on or before Election Day)
- ✓ be a resident of Connecticut
- have completed confinement and parole if previously convicted of a disenfranchising felony, and re-register

REGISTRATION DEADLINE 2020: OCTOBER 27 Online (driver's license or DMV-issued ID required) or received in the mail by the Registrar. Register on Election Day as a last resort – likely delays could risk your ability to vote.

VOTE

Go to Iwvstamford.org homepage Quick Links -Voter Lookup to find your polling place or confirmation that your Absentee Ballot was received.

- ✓ Vote at the polls on November 3 between 6am and 8pm OR
- ✓ Vote by Absentee Ballot which must be received by the Town Clerk or in a Drop Box by November 3 at 8pm
- ✓ DEADLINE: BALLOT RECEIVED BY NOVEMBER 3 AT 8 PM

VOTING TIPS

MID-SEPTEMBER (Earliest)

• Look for your Application in the mail. Quickly submit your Application by mail to the Town Clerk's Office OR place it in a Drop Box.

OCTOBER 3rd (Earliest)

 Look for your Ballot in the mail. Carefully complete, sign and date it and place it in the envelopes correctly.

TWO WEEKS BEFORE **NOVEMBER 3RD** (At Least)

- Mail your Ballot back to the Town Clerk
- Put it in a Drop Box before Election Day
